Mr. SPRATT (for himself, Mr. CLYBURN, Mr. ROTHMAN, Mr. RUPPERSBERGER, and Mr. BARTLETT of Maryland) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

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## A BILL

To authorize funding for the National Advocacy Center.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. TRAINING AT THE NATIONAL ADVOCACY CEN-**  
4       **TER.**

5       The National District Attorneys Association may use  
6       the services of the National Advocacy Center in Columbia,  
7       South Carolina to conduct a national training program for  
8       State and local prosecutors for the purpose of improving  
9       the professional skills of State and local prosecutors and  
10      enhancing the ability of Federal, State, and local prosecu-  
11      tors to work together.

1 **SEC. 2. COMPREHENSIVE CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION.**

2       The National Advocacy Center in Columbia, South  
3 Carolina may provide comprehensive continuing legal edu-  
4 cation in the areas of trial practice, substantive legal up-  
5 dates, and support staff training.

6 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7       There are authorized to be appropriated to the Attor-  
8 ney General to carry out this Act \$6,500,000 for each of  
9 the fiscal years 2009 through 2012 to remain available  
10 until expended.

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
