5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 101 Tallapoosa Street in Bre-
7 men, Georgia, shall be known and designated as the “Ser-
8 geant Paul Saylor Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sergeant Paul Saylor
5 Post Office Building”.
