Ms. CASTOR, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5715) to ensure continued availability of access to the Federal student loan program for students and families.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the State of the Union for consid-
5 eration of the bill (H.R. 5715) to ensure continued avail-
6 ability of access to the Federal student loan program for
7 students and families. The first reading of the bill shall

1 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-
2 ation of the bill are waived except those arising under
3 clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. General debate shall be con-
4 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
5 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
6 ity member of the Committee on Education and Labor.
7 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
8 amendment under the five-minute rule. The amendment
9 printed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules
10 accompanying this resolution shall be considered as adopt-
11 ed in the House and in the Committee of the Whole. The
12 bill, as amended, shall be considered as the original bill
13 for the purpose of further amendment under the five-
14 minute rule and shall be considered as read. All points
15 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
16 waived. Notwithstanding clause 11 of rule XVIII, no fur-
17 ther amendment to the bill, as amended, shall be in order
18 except those printed in part B of the report of the Com-
19 mittee on Rules. Each further amendment may be offered
20 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
21 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
22 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
23 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
24 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-
25 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division

1 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
2 Whole. All points of order against such further amend-
3 ments are waived except those arising under clause 9 or
4 10 of rule XXI. At the conclusion of consideration of the
5 bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and report
6 the bill, as amended, to the House with such further
7 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
8 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
9 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
10 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
11 structions.

12 SEC. 2. During consideration in the House of H.R.
13 5715 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the op-
14 eration of the previous question, the Chair may postpone
15 further consideration of the bill to such time as may be
16 designated by the Speaker.
