RESOLUTION

Expressing disapproval by the House of Representatives of the totalization agreement between the United States and Mexico signed by the Commissioner of Social Security and the Director General of the Mexican Social Security Institute on June 29, 2004.

Whereas a totalization agreement between the United States and Mexico was signed by the Commissioner of Social Security and the Director General of the Mexican Social Security Institute on June 29, 2004;

Whereas a totalization agreement between the United States and Mexico negatively impacts the Social Security system

of the United States and puts America's seniors at risk;
and

Whereas upon transmittal of such agreement to the Congress,
under section 233(e)(2) of the Social Security Act, such
agreement is subject to disapproval by either House of
the Congress: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives, pursu-
2 ant to section 233(e)(2) of the Social Security Act, hereby
3 disapproves the totalization agreement establishing total-
4 ization arrangements between the social security system
5 established by title II of such Act and the social security
6 system of Mexico, signed by the Commissioner of Social
7 Security and the Director General, Mexican Social Secu-
8 rity Institute, on June 29, 2004.
