### ***In the House of Representatives, U. S.,***

*June 26, 2008.*

Whereas the Chevrolet Corvette is America's first sports car;

Whereas the first production Corvette rolled off a Flint,  
Michigan, assembly line on June 30, 1953;

Whereas the Corvette is now manufactured in Bowling Green,  
Kentucky;

Whereas the Corvette is the most widely respected production  
sports car in United States history;

Whereas the Corvette is truly a symbol of American pride;

Whereas General Motors is celebrating its 100th anniversary  
in 2008; and

Whereas the 30th of June would be an appropriate day to  
designate as "National Corvette Day": Now, therefore, be  
it

*Resolved*, That the United States House of Representa-  
tives supports the designation of a "National Corvette Day"  
to honor the Chevrolet Corvette.
