A BILL

To redesignate the White Rocks National Recreation Area in the State of Vermont as the “Robert T. Stafford White Rocks National Recreation Area”.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ROBERT T. STAFFORD WHITE ROCKS NATIONAL**
4 **RECREATION AREA.**

5 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The White Rocks National
6 Recreation Area in the State of Vermont, as established
7 by section 202 of the Vermont Wilderness Act of 1984
8 (16 U.S.C. 460nn–1), is redesignated as the “Robert T.
9 Stafford White Rocks National Recreation Area”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the recreation area referred to in subsection (a)
4 shall be deemed to be a reference to the Robert T. Stafford
5 White Rocks National Recreation Area.
