AN ACT

To designate the federally occupied building located at McKinley Avenue and Third Street, SW., Canton, Ohio, as the “Ralph Regula Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. RALPH REGULA FEDERAL BUILDING AND**
2 **UNITED STATES COURTHOUSE.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Administrator of General
4 Services shall ensure that the federally occupied building
5 located at McKinley Avenue and Third Street, SW., Can-
6 ton, Ohio, is known and designated as the “Ralph Regula
7 Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—With respect to the period in
9 which the building referred to in subsection (a) is federally
10 occupied, any reference in a law, map, regulation, docu-
11 ment, paper, or other record of the United States to that
12 building shall be deemed to be a reference to the “Ralph
13 Regula Federal Building and United States Courthouse”.
