3 **SECTION 1. JOHN S. WILDER POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 116 North West Street in Somer-
6 ville, Tennessee, shall be known and designated as the
7 “John S. Wilder Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

- 1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
- 2 be deemed to be a reference to the “John S. Wilder Post
- 3 Office Building”.
