A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. LAREDO VETERANS POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 1300 Matamoros Street in La-

1 redo, Texas, shall be known and designated as the “La-
2 redo Veterans Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Laredo Veterans Post
7 Office”.

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
