AN ACT

To authorize the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation
to establish a commemorative work in the District of
Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. MEMORIAL TO COMMEMORATE THE ESTAB-**
2 **LISHMENT OF THE PEACE CORPS AND TO**
3 **HONOR THE IDEALS UPON WHICH IT WAS**
4 **FOUNDED.**

5 (a) **AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORA-**
6 **TIVE WORK.**—The Peace Corps Commemorative Founda-
7 tion may establish a commemorative work on Federal land
8 in the District of Columbia and its environs to commemo-
9 rate the formation of the Peace Corps and to honor the
10 ideals upon which the Peace Corps was founded.

11 (b) **COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-**
12 **RATIVE WORKS ACT.**—The establishment of the com-
13 memorative work shall be in accordance with chapter 89
14 of title 40, United States Code (commonly known as the
15 “Commemorative Works Act”).

16 (c) **USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS PROHIBITED.**—Federal
17 funds may not be used to pay any expense of the establish-
18 ment of the commemorative work. The Peace Corps Com-
19 memorative Foundation shall be solely responsible for ac-
20 ceptance of contributions for, and payment of the expenses
21 of, the establishment of the commemorative work.

22 (d) **DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.**—If, upon payment
23 of all expenses for the establishment of the commemora-
24 tive work (including the maintenance and preservation
25 amount required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United
26 States Code), or upon expiration of the authority for the

1 commemorative work under section 8903(e) of title 40,
2 United States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-
3 ceived for the establishment of the commemorative work,
4 the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation shall trans-
5 mit the amount of the balance to the Secretary of the Inte-
6 rior for deposit in the account provided for in section
7 8906(b)(3) of title 40, United States Code.

8 **SEC. 2. BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

9 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
10 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010,
11 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
12 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
13 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
14 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro-
15 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the
16 vote on passage.
