Mr. YOUNG of Alaska introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Homeland Security

A BILL

To amend title 46, United States Code, to require delivery by United States mail of any transportation security card issued to an individual who resides in a remote location.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “TWIC Delivery Act
5 of 2010”.

1 **SEC. 2. DELIVERY OF TRANSPORTATION SECURITY CARDS**
2 **TO INDIVIDUALS WHO RESIDE IN REMOTE**
3 **LOCATIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 70105(b) of title 46,
5 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
6 following new paragraph:

7 “(3) In the case of a transportation security card
8 issued under this section to an individual who resides in
9 a location where the nearest transportation security card
10 enrollment center is not accessible by a State or Federal
11 road or is more than 100 miles from the location, the Sec-
12 retary shall deliver the card to the individual by United
13 States mail.”.

14 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
15 section (a) shall apply to a transportation security card
16 issued after the date of the enactment of this Act.
