AN ACT

To amend title 11 of the United States Code to include firearms in the types of property allowable under the alternative provision for exempting property from the estate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Gun Own-
3 ers in Bankruptcy Act of 2010”.

4 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTIONS.**

5 Section 522 of title 11, the United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subsection (d) by adding at the end the
8 following:

9 “(13) The debtor’s aggregate interest, not to
10 exceed \$3,000 in value, in a single rifle, shotgun, or
11 pistol, or any combination thereof.”, and

12 (2) in subsection (f)(4)(A)—

13 (A) in clause (xiv) by striking “and” at the
14 end,

15 (B) in clause (xv) by striking the period at
16 the end and inserting “; and”, and

17 (C) by adding at the end the following:

18 “(xvi) The debtor’s aggregate interest, not to
19 exceed \$3,000 in value, in a single rifle, shotgun, or
20 pistol, or any combination thereof.”.

21 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**

22 (a) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Except as provided in sub-
23 section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this
24 Act shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this
25 Act.

1 (b) APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.—The amend-
2 ments made by this Act shall apply only with respect to
3 cases commenced under title 11 of the United States Code
4 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
