AN ACT

To amend title 11 of the United States Code to include firearms in the types of property allowable under the alternative provision for exempting property from the estate.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Gun Own-
5 ers in Bankruptcy Act of 2010”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTIONS.**

2 Section 522 of title 11, the United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) in subsection (d) by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 “(13) The debtor’s aggregate interest, not to
7 exceed \$3,000 in value, in a single rifle, shotgun, or
8 pistol, or any combination thereof.”, and

9 (2) in subsection (f)(4)(A)—

10 (A) in clause (xiv) by striking “and” at the
11 end,

12 (B) in clause (xv) by striking the period at
13 the end and inserting “; and”, and

14 (C) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(xvi) The debtor’s aggregate interest, not to
16 exceed \$3,000 in value, in a single rifle, shotgun, or
17 pistol, or any combination thereof.”.

18 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**

19 (a) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—Except as provided in sub-
20 section (b), this Act and the amendments made by this
21 Act shall take effect on the date of the enactment of this
22 Act.

23 (b) **APPLICATION OF AMENDMENTS.**—The amend-
24 ments made by this Act shall apply only with respect to

1 cases commenced under title 11 of the United States Code
2 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
