A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SAM SACCO POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

2 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
3 Postal Service located at 337 West Clark Street in Eureka,
4 California, shall be known and designated as the “Sam
5 Sacco Post Office Building”.

6 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, regulation,
7 document, paper, or other record of the United
8 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
9 be deemed to be a reference to the “Sam Sacco Post Office
10 Building”.

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
