Mr. PAUL introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee

A BILL

To ensure that certain Federal employees cannot hide behind
immunity.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Traveller
5 Dignity Act of 2010”.

6 **SEC. 2. NO IMMUNITY FOR CERTAIN AIRPORT SCREENING**
7 **METHODS.**

8 No law of the United States shall be construed to
9 confer any immunity for a Federal employee or agency or
10 any individual or entity that receives Federal funds, who
11 subjects an individual to any physical contact (including

1 contact with any clothing the individual is wearing), x-
2 rays, or millimeter waves, or aids in the creation of or
3 views a representation of any part of a individual's body
4 covered by clothing as a condition for such individual to
5 be in an airport or to fly in an aircraft. The preceding
6 sentence shall apply even if the individual or the individ-
7 ual's parent, guardian, or any other individual gives con-
8 sent.
