1 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

2 The Federal building located at 799 United Nations
3 Plaza in New York, New York, shall be known and des-
4 ignated as the “Ronald H. Brown United States Mission
5 to the United Nations Building”.

6 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

7 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
8 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
9 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
10 a reference to the “Ronald H. Brown United States Mis-
11 sion to the United Nations Building”.

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
