5 Regional Water Recycling Program, and for other pur-
6 poses. All points of order against consideration of the bill

1 are waived except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of
2 rule XXI. The amendment printed in the report of the
3 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be
4 considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be con-
5 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in
6 the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question
7 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,
8 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
9 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Nat-
11 ural Resources; and (2) one motion to recommit with or
12 without instructions.
