To amend the Act of August 9, 1955, to authorize the Coquille Indian Tribe, the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians, the Confederated Tribes of the Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Siuslaw, the Klamath Tribes, and the Burns Paiute Tribe to obtain 99-year lease authority for trust land.

3 **SECTION 1. LEASES OF RESTRICTED LAND.**

4 Subsection (a) of the first section of the Act of Au-
5 gust 9, 1955 (25 U.S.C. 415(a)), is amended in the second
6 sentence by inserting “land held in trust for the Coquille

1 Indian Tribe, land held in trust for the Confederated
2 Tribes of Siletz Indians, land held in trust for the Confed-
3 erated Tribes of the Coos, Lower Umpqua, and Siuslaw
4 Indians, land held in trust for the Klamath Tribes, and
5 land held in trust for the Burns Paiute Tribe,” after
6 “lands held in trust for the Confederated Tribes of the
7 Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon,”.
