1 **SECTION 1. REPEALING MANDATORY FUNDING FOR**
2 **SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTER CONSTRUC-**
3 **TION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (a) of section 4101 of
5 the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (42
6 U.S.C. 280h–4) is repealed.

7 (b) RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED FUNDS.—Of the
8 funds made available by section 4101(a) of the Patient
9 Protection and Affordable Care Act (42 U.S.C. 280h–
10 4(a)), the unobligated balance is rescinded.
