- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON FAMILY MEMBER VISITATION
- 4 OF INDIVIDUALS DETAINED AT NAVAL STA-
- 5 TION, GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA.
- 6 (a) Prohibition.—The Secretary of Defense shall
- 7 ensure that no person who is a family member of an indi-
- 8 vidual detained at Guantanamo is permitted to visit the

- 1 individual at United States Naval Station, Guantanamo
- 2 Bay, Cuba.
- 3 (b) Individual Detained at Guantanamo De-
- 4 FINED.—In this Act, the term "individual detained at
- 5 Guantanamo" means any individual who is located at
- 6 United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, on
- 7 or after March 7, 2011, who—
- 8 (1) is not a citizen of the United States or a
- 9 member of the Armed Forces of the United States;
- 10 and
- 11 (2) is in the custody or under the effective con-
- trol of the Department of Defense.
