A BILL

To exempt the natural aging process in the determination of the production period for distilled spirits under section 263A of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Aged Distilled Spirits
5 Competitiveness Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION OF NATURAL AGING PROCESS IN DE-**
2 **TERMINATION OF PRODUCTION PERIOD FOR**
3 **DISTILLED SPIRITS UNDER SECTION 263A.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 263A(f) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to general exceptions) is
6 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
7 graph:

8 “(5) **EXEMPTION OF NATURAL AGING PROCESS**
9 **IN DETERMINATION OF PRODUCTION PERIOD FOR**
10 **DISTILLED SPIRITS.**—For purposes of this sub-
11 section, the production period for distilled spirits
12 shall be determined without regard to any period al-
13 located to the natural aging process.”.

14 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
15 this section shall apply to production periods beginning
16 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
