3 **SECTION 1. HARRY T. AND HARRIETTE MOORE POST OF-**
4 **FICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 600 Florida Avenue in Cocoa,

1 Florida, shall be known and designated as the “Harry T.
2 and Harriette Moore Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Harry T. and Har-
7 riette Moore Post Office”.
