2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

4 Section 2710(b)(2) of title 18, United States Code,
5 is amended by striking subparagraph (B) and inserting
6 the following:

1 “(B) to any person with the informed,
2 written consent (including through an electronic
3 means using the Internet) of the consumer
4 given at one or both of the following times:

5 “(i) The time the disclosure is sought.

6 “(ii) In advance for a set period of
7 time or until consent is withdrawn by such
8 consumer.”.
