## A BILL

To amend title 44, United States Code, to repeal the National Historical Publications and Records Commission, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Wasting Archive  
5 Grants Act of 2011”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF NATIONAL HISTORICAL PUBLICATIONS**  
2 **AND RECORDS COMMISSION.**

3 (a) REPEAL.—Chapter 25 of title 44, United States  
4 Code, is repealed.

5 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
6 at the beginning of such chapter is repealed.

7 **SEC. 3. RESCISSION OF UNOBLIGATED FUNDS.**

8 The unobligated balance of funds made available to  
9 the National Historical Publications and Records Commis-  
10 sion, including amounts made available by section 1561  
11 of Public Law 112–10 (125 Stat. 137), is rescinded.
