## A BILL

To repeal the rule requiring employers to post notices relating to the National Labor Relations Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Employee Workplace  
5 Freedom Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF FINAL RULE.**

7 (a) REPEAL.—The final rule (including any supple-  
8 ment or revision to such rule) published by the National  
9 Labor Relations Board in the Federal Register on August  
10 30, 2011 (76 Fed. Reg. 54006 et seq.), is repealed.

1           (b) RULES REQUIRING NLRA NOTICES PROHIB-  
2 ITED.—The National Labor Relations Board shall not  
3 promulgate or enforce any rule that requires employers to  
4 post notices relating to the National Labor Relations Act  
5 (29 U.S.C. 151 et seq.) on or after the date of enactment  
6 of this section.
