Mr. DENHAM (for himself, Ms. NORTON, and Mr. HANNA) introduced the fol-
lowing bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and
Infrastructure

A BILL

To reauthorize the programs and activities of the Federal
Emergency Management Agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FEMA Reauthoriza-
5 tion Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF URBAN SEARCH AND RES-**
7 **CUE RESPONSE SYSTEM.**

8 Section 634 of Public Law 109–295 (6 U.S.C. 722)
9 is amended by striking subsection (b) and inserting the
10 following:

1 “(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
2 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out the system
3 \$35,250,000 for each of fiscal years 2012 and 2013.”.

4 **SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**
5 **ASSISTANCE COMPACT GRANTS.**

6 Section 661 of Public Law 109–295 (6 U.S.C. 761)
7 is amended by striking subsection (d) and inserting the
8 following:

9 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
10 is authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
11 \$2,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2012 and 2013.
12 Such sums shall remain available until expended.”.

13 **SEC. 4. REAUTHORIZATION OF FEDERAL EMERGENCY MAN-**
14 **AGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION.**

15 Section 699 of Public Law 109–295 (6 U.S.C. 811)
16 is amended:

17 (1) by striking “administration and operations”
18 each place it appears and inserting “management
19 and administration”;

20 (2) in paragraph (2) by striking “and”;

21 (3) in paragraph (3) by striking the period and
22 inserting “; and”; and

23 (4) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(4) for fiscal year 2012, \$813,000,000, includ-
2 ing amounts transferred from the Disaster Relief
3 Fund; and

4 “(5) for fiscal year 2013, \$813,000,000, includ-
5 ing amounts transferred from the Disaster Relief
6 Fund.”.
