A BILL

To delist the polar bear as a threatened species under the Endangered Species Act of 1973.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Polar Bear Delisting
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DELISTING OF POLAR BEAR AS THREATENED SPE-**
7 **CIES.**

8 The determination by the United States Fish and
9 Wildlife of the threatened status for the polar bear (*Ursus*
10 *maritimus*) under the Endangered Species Act of 1973

1 (16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.), published May 15, 2008 (73
2 Fed. Reg. 28211 et seq.), and the listing of such species
3 as a threatened species under that Act pursuant to such
4 determination, shall have no force or effect.
