3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoring Democracy
5 in the Workplace Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF RULE.**

7 Effective January 1, 2011, the rule prescribed by the
8 National Mediation Board relating to representation elec-
9 tion procedures published on May 11, 2010 (95 Fed. Reg.

- 1 26062) and revising sections 1202 and 1206 of title 29,
- 2 Code of Federal Regulations, shall have no force or effect.
