## A BILL

To extend the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 for five years.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “FISA Amendments  
5 Act Reauthorization Act of 2012”.

1 **SEC. 2. FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OF FISA AMENDMENTS ACT**  
2 **OF 2008.**

3 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 403(b) of the FISA  
4 Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–261; 122 Stat.  
5 2474) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “December  
7 31, 2012” and inserting “December 31, 2017”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (2) in the material preceding  
9 subparagraph (A), by striking “December 31, 2012”  
10 and inserting “December 31, 2017”.

11 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The heading of sec-  
12 tion 404(b) of the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 (Public  
13 Law 110–261; 122 Stat. 2476) is amended by striking  
14 “DECEMBER 31, 2012” and inserting “DECEMBER 31,  
15 2017”.
