

In the Senate of the United States,

January 1 (legislative day, December 30, 2012), 2013.

Resolved, That the bill from the House of Representatives (H.R. 6586) entitled “An Act to extend the application of certain space launch liability provisions through 2014.”, do pass with the following

AMENDMENT:

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 ***SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.***

2 *This Act may be cited as the “Space Exploration Sus-*
3 *tainability Act”.*

4 ***SEC. 2. ASSURANCE OF CORE CAPABILITIES.***

5 *Section 203 of the National Aeronautics and Space*
6 *Administration Authorization Act of 2010 (42 U.S.C.*
7 *18313) is amended by adding at the end the following:*

8 *“(c) SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING HUMAN SPACE*
9 *FLIGHT CAPABILITY ASSURANCE.—It is the sense of Con-*
10 *gress that the Administrator shall proceed with the utiliza-*

1 *tion of the ISS, technology development, and follow-on*
2 *transportation systems (including the Space Launch Sys-*
3 *tem, multi-purpose crew vehicle, and commercial crew and*
4 *cargo transportation capabilities) under titles III and IV*
5 *of this Act in a manner that ensures—*

6 “(1) *that these capabilities remain inherently*
7 *complementary and interrelated;*

8 “(2) *a balance of the development, sustainment,*
9 *and use of each of these capabilities, which are of crit-*
10 *ical importance to the viability and sustainability of*
11 *the U.S. space program; and*

12 “(3) *that resources required to support the timely*
13 *and sustainable development of these capabilities au-*
14 *thorized in either title III or title IV of this Act are*
15 *not derived from a reduction in resources for the ca-*
16 *pabilities authorized in the other title.*

17 “(d) *LIMITATION.—Nothing in subsection (c) shall*
18 *apply to or affect any capability authorized by any other*
19 *title of this Act”.*

20 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN SPACE LAUNCH LIABILITY**
21 **PROVISIONS.**

22 *Section 50915(f) of title 51, United States Code, is*
23 *amended by striking “December 31, 2012” and inserting*
24 *“December 31, 2013”.*

1 **SEC. 4. EXEMPTION FROM INKSNA.**

2 *Section 7(1)(B) of the Iran, North Korea, and Syria*
3 *Nonproliferation Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—*

4 *(1) by striking “, or for the purchase of goods or*
5 *services relating to human space flight, that are”; and*

6 *(2) by striking “prior to July 1, 2016” and in-*
7 *serting “prior to December 31, 2020”.*
