A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to eliminate certain limitations on the length of Secret Service Protection for former Presidents and for the children of former Presidents.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Former Presidents
5 Protection Act of 2012”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATING CERTAIN LIMITATIONS ON THE**
2 **LENGTH OF SECRET SERVICE PROTECTION**
3 **FOR FORMER PRESIDENTS AND FOR THE**
4 **CHILDREN OF FORMER PRESIDENTS.**

5 (a) **FORMER PRESIDENTS.**—Section 3056(a)(3) of
6 title 18, United States Code, is amended by striking “un-
7 less the former President did not” and all that follows
8 through “warrant such protection”.

9 (b) **CHILDREN OF FORMER PRESIDENTS.**—Section
10 3056(a)(4) of title 18, United States Code, is amended
11 by striking “for a period” and all that follows through
12 “comes first”.
