A BILL

To amend the Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 to allow the importation of polar bear trophies taken in sport hunts in Canada.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoration of the
5 U.S.-Russia Polar Bear Conservation Fund Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. PERMITS FOR IMPORTATION OF POLAR BEAR TRO-**
7 **PHIES.**

8 The Marine Mammal Protection Act of 1972 is
9 amended—

1 (1) in section 101(a)(3)(B) (16 U.S.C.
2 1371(a)(3)(B)), by inserting “or under section
3 104(c)(5) of this title” after “paragraph (5) of this
4 subsection”; and

5 (2) in section 102(b)(3) (16 U.S.C.
6 1372(b)(3)), by inserting before the semicolon the
7 following: “, except that this paragraph does not
8 prohibit the importation of polar bear parts under a
9 permit issued under section 104(c)(5) of this title”.
