RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 662) to provide an extension of Federal-aid highway, highway safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other programs funded out of the Highway Trust Fund pending enactment of a multiyear law reauthorizing such programs.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 662) to provide an extension of Federal-aid highway, high-
4 way safety, motor carrier safety, transit, and other pro-
5 grams funded out of the Highway Trust Fund pending

1 enactment of a multiyear law reauthorizing such pro-
2 grams. All points of order against consideration of the bill
3 are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points
4 of order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
5 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
6 and any amendment thereto to final passage without inter-
7 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
8 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
9 member of the Committee on Transportation and Infra-
10 structure; (2) the amendment printed in the report of the
11 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, if of-
12 fered by Representative Mica of Florida or his designee,
13 which shall be in order without intervention of any point
14 of order, shall be considered as read, shall be separately
15 debatable for 10 minutes equally divided and controlled
16 by the proponent and an opponent, and shall not be sub-
17 ject to a demand for a division of the question; and (3)
18 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
