6 tion are waived. The joint resolution shall be considered
7 as read. All points of order against provisions in the joint

1 resolution are waived. The previous question shall be con-
2 sidered as ordered on the joint resolution to final passage
3 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
4 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
5 minority member of the Committee on Appropriations;
6 and (2) one motion to recommit.
