RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 471) to reauthorize the DC opportunity scholarship program, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 471) to reauthorize the DC opportunity scholarship pro-
4 gram, and for other purposes. All points of order against
5 consideration of the bill are waived. The amendment rec-
6 ommended by the Committee on Oversight and Govern-
7 ment Reform now printed in the bill shall be considered

1 as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as
2 read. All points of order against provisions in the bill, as
3 amended, are waived. The previous question shall be con-
4 sidered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
5 further amendment thereto, to final passage without inter-
6 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
7 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
8 member of the Committee on Oversight and Government
9 Reform; (2) the further amendment printed in the report
10 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution,
11 if offered by Delegate Norton of the District of Columbia
12 or her designee, which shall be in order without interven-
13 tion of any point of order, shall be considered as read,
14 and shall be separately debatable for 40 minutes equally
15 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;
16 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
17 tions.
