Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1255) to prevent a shutdown of the government of the United States, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1255) to prevent a shutdown of the government of the
4 United States, and for other purposes. All points of order
5 against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall
6 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-
7 sions in the bill are waived. The previous question shall

1 be considered as ordered on the bill to final passage with-
2 out intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
3 equally divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and
4 Minority Leader or their respective designees; and (2) one
5 motion to recommit.
