RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1473) making appropriations for the Department of Defense and the other departments and agencies of the Government for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 35) directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make a correction in the enrollment of H.R. 1473; and providing for consideration

of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 36) directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make a correction in the enrollment of H.R. 1473.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 1473) making appropriations for the Department of De-
4 fense and the other departments and agencies of the Gov-
5 ernment for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011,
6 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-
7 eration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered
8 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill
9 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as
10 ordered on the bill to final passage without intervening
11 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
12 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
13 the Committee on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to
14 recommit.

15 SEC. 2. (a) If H.R. 1473 is passed by the House,
16 it shall be in order to consider separately in the House
17 the concurrent resolutions specified in subsection (b). All
18 points of order against consideration of each concurrent
19 resolution are waived. Each concurrent resolution shall be
20 considered read. The previous question shall be considered
21 as ordered on each concurrent resolution to final adoption
22 without intervening motion except 20 minutes of debate

1 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking
2 minority member of the Committee on Appropriations.

3 (b) The concurrent resolutions specified in subsection
4 (a) are as follows:

5 (1) the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 35)
6 directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives
7 to make a correction in the enrollment of H.R.
8 1473; and

9 (2) the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 36)
10 directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives
11 to make a correction in the enrollment of H.R.
12 1473.

13 SEC. 3. If the House receives a message from the
14 Senate transmitting its passage of H.R. 1473 without
15 amendment, then the Clerk shall not certify an enrollment
16 of the bill until notified by the Speaker or by message from
17 the Senate that the Senate has taken the question on
18 adoption of each concurrent resolution specified in section
19 2 that was adopted by the House.
