Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1216) to amend the Public Health Service Act to convert funding for graduate medical education in qualified teaching health centers from direct appropriations to an authorization of appropriations; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1540) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2012 for military activities of the Department of Defense and for military construction, to prescribe military personnel strengths for fiscal year 2012, and for other purposes; and waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

Ms. FOXX, from the Committee on Rules; reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1216) to amend the Public Health Service Act to convert funding for graduate medical education in qualified teaching health centers from direct appropriations to an authorization of appropriations; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1540) to authorize appropriations for fiscal year 2012 for military activities of the Department of Defense

and for military construction, to prescribe military personnel strengths for fiscal year 2012, and for other purposes; and waiving a requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII with respect to consideration of certain resolutions reported from the Committee on Rules.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1216) to amend the Public Health  
6 Service Act to convert funding for graduate medical edu-  
7 cation in qualified teaching health centers from direct ap-  
8 propriations to an authorization of appropriations. The  
9 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points  
10 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-  
11 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-  
12 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair  
13 and ranking minority member of the Committee on En-  
14 ergy and Commerce. After general debate the bill shall be  
15 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The  
16 bill shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
17 provisions in the bill are waived. No amendment to the  
18 bill shall be in order except those received for printing in  
19 the portion of the Congressional Record designated for  
20 that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII in a daily issue  
21 dated May 23, 2011, and except pro forma amendments

1 for the purpose of debate. Each amendment so received  
2 may be offered only by the Member who caused it to be  
3 printed or a designee and shall be considered as read if  
4 printed. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for  
5 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill  
6 to the House with such amendments as may have been  
7 adopted. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
8 dered on the bill and amendments thereto to final passage  
9 without intervening motion except one motion to recommit  
10 with or without instructions.

11       SEC. 2. At any time after the adoption of this resolu-  
12 tion the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
13 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of  
14 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
15 ation of the bill (H.R. 1540) to authorize appropriations  
16 for fiscal year 2012 for military activities of the Depart-  
17 ment of Defense and for military construction, to prescribe  
18 military personnel strengths for fiscal year 2012, and for  
19 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-  
20 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of  
21 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to  
22 the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and  
23 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of  
24 the Committee on Armed Services. After general debate,  
25 the Committee of the Whole shall rise without motion. No

1 further consideration of the bill shall be in order except  
2 pursuant to a subsequent order of the House.

3       SEC. 3. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII  
4 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-  
5 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the  
6 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported  
7 through the legislative day of May 27, 2011, providing for  
8 consideration or disposition of a measure addressing expir-  
9 ing provisions of the USA PATRIOT Improvement and  
10 Reauthorization Act of 2005.
