Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2584) making appropriations for the Department of the Interior, environment, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2584) making appropriations for

1 the Department of the Interior, environment, and related  
2 agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012,  
3 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall  
4 be dispensed with. All points of order against consider-  
5 ation of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-  
6 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-  
7 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
8 member of the Committee on Appropriations. After gen-  
9 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
10 under the five-minute rule. The amendment printed in sec-  
11 tion 2 of this resolution shall be considered as adopted  
12 in the House and in the Committee of the Whole. Points  
13 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, for fail-  
14 ure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. Dur-  
15 ing consideration of the bill for further amendment, the  
16 chair of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority  
17 in recognition on the basis of whether the Member offering  
18 an amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion  
19 of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose  
20 in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall  
21 be considered as read. When the committee rises and re-  
22 ports the bill, as amended, back to the House with a rec-  
23 ommendation that the bill do pass, the previous question  
24 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
25 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-

1 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or  
2 without instructions.

3       SEC. 2. The amendment considered as adopted in the  
4 House and in the Committee of the Whole is as follows:  
5 Strike section 427.
