Mr. BISHOP of Utah, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2401) to require analyses of the cumulative and incremental impacts of certain rules and actions of the Environmental Protection Agency, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2401) to require analyses of the

1 cumulative and incremental impacts of certain rules and
2 actions of the Environmental Protection Agency, and for
3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
4 pensed with. All points of order against consideration of
5 the bill are waived. General debate shall be confined to
6 the bill and shall not exceed two hours equally divided and
7 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
8 the Committee on Energy and Commerce. After general
9 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under
10 the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as
11 an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the
12 five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-
13 stitute recommended by the Committee on Energy and
14 Commerce now printed in the bill. The committee amend-
15 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered as
16 read. All points of order against the committee amend-
17 ment in the nature of a substitute are waived. No amend-
18 ment to the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-
19 stitute shall be in order except those printed in the report
20 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution.
21 Each such amendment may be offered only in the order
22 printed in the report, may be offered only by a Member
23 designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
24 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
25 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,

1 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
2 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
3 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
4 against such amendments are waived. At the conclusion
5 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
6 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
7 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may
8 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment
9 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to
10 the committee amendment in the nature of a substitute.
11 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
12 the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without
13 intervening motion except one motion to recommit with
14 or without instructions.
