Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 2832) to extend the Generalized System of Preferences, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 2832) to extend the Generalized System of Pref-
4 erences, and for other purposes, with the Senate amend-
5 ment thereto, and to consider in the House, without inter-
6 vention of any point of order, a motion offered by the chair
7 of the Committee on Ways and Means or his designee that

1 the House concur in the Senate amendment. The Senate
2 amendment shall be considered as read. The motion shall
3 be debatable for one hour equally divided and controlled
4 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-
5 mittee on Ways and Means. The previous question shall
6 be considered as ordered on the motion to its adoption
7 without intervening motion.
