Con. Res. 94) directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make corrections in the enrollment of H.R. 3672; and for other purposes.

Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the conference report to accompany the bill (H.R. 2055) making appropriations for military construction, the Department of Veterans Affairs, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3672) making appropriations for disaster relief requirements for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other purposes;

providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 94) directing the Clerk of the House of Representatives to make corrections in the enrollment of H.R. 3672; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider the conference report to ac-
3 company the bill (H.R. 2055) making appropriations for
4 military construction, the Department of Veterans Affairs,
5 and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September
6 30, 2012, and for other purposes. All points of order
7 against the conference report and against its consideration
8 are waived. The conference report shall be considered as
9 read. The previous question shall be considered as ordered
10 on the conference report to its adoption without inter-
11 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate; and (2) one
12 motion to recommit if applicable.

13 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
14 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3672)
15 making appropriations for disaster relief requirements for
16 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, and for other
17 purposes. All points of order against consideration of the
18 bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All
19 points of order against provisions in the bill are waived.
20 The previous question shall be considered as ordered on
21 the bill to final passage without intervening motion except:
22 (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by

1 the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee
2 on Appropriations; and (2) one motion to recommit.

3 SEC. 3. Upon adoption of this resolution, it shall be
4 in order to consider in the House the concurrent resolution
5 (H. Con. Res. 94) directing the Clerk of the House of Rep-
6 resentatives to make corrections in the enrollment of H.R.
7 3672. All points of order against consideration of the con-
8 current resolution are waived. The concurrent resolution
9 shall be considered as read. All points of order against
10 provisions in the concurrent resolution are waived. The
11 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
12 concurrent resolution to its adoption without intervening
13 motion except: (1) 20 minutes of debate equally divided
14 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member
15 of the Committee on Appropriations; and (2) one motion
16 to recommit which may not contain instructions.

17 SEC. 4. The Clerk shall not transmit to the Senate
18 a message that the House has passed H.R. 3672 until no-
19 tified by the Speaker or by message from the Senate that
20 the Senate has taken the question on adoption of House
21 Concurrent Resolution 94 as adopted by the House.

22 SEC. 5. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-
23 tive day of December 16, 2011, for the Speaker to enter-
24 tain motions that the House suspend the rules, as though
25 under clause 1(c) of rule XV, relating to a measure con-

1 tinuing appropriations for the fiscal year ending Sep-
2 tember 30, 2012.

3 SEC. 6. The requirement of clause 6(a) of rule XIII
4 for a two-thirds vote to consider a report from the Com-
5 mittee on Rules on the same day it is presented to the
6 House is waived with respect to any resolution reported
7 through the legislative day of December 31, 2011, pro-
8 viding for consideration or disposition of any of the fol-
9 lowing measures:

10 (1) A measure relating to expiring provisions of
11 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

12 (2) A measure relating to the Medicare pay-
13 ment system for physicians.

14 (3) A measure relating to appropriations for the
15 fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

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
