Ms. FOXX, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 359) to reduce Federal spending and the deficit by terminating taxpayer financing of presidential election campaigns and party conventions.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 359) to reduce Federal spending
6 and the deficit by terminating taxpayer financing of presi-

1 denial election campaigns and party conventions. The
2 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
3 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
4 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
5 ceed one hour equally divided among and controlled by the
6 chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on
7 Ways and Means and the chair and ranking minority
8 member of the Committee on House Administration. After
9 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
10 under the five-minute rule for a period not to exceed five
11 hours. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
12 order against provisions in the bill are waived. No amend-
13 ment to the bill shall be in order except those printed in
14 the portion of the Congressional Record designated for
15 that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII and except pro-
16 forma amendments for the purpose of debate. Each
17 amendment so printed may be offered only by the Member
18 who caused it to be printed or a designee and shall be
19 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
20 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-
21 port the bill to the House with such amendments as may
22 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-
23 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
24 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
25 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
