RESOLUTION

Relating to the consideration of House Report 112-546 and an accompanying resolution, and providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 706) authorizing the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform to initiate or intervene in judicial proceedings to enforce certain subpoenas.

- 1 *Resolved*, That if House Report 112-546 is called up
- 2 by direction of the Committee on Oversight and Govern-

1 ment Reform: (a) all points of order against the report
2 are waived and the report shall be considered as read; and

3 (b)(1) an accompanying resolution offered by direc-
4 tion of the Committee on Oversight and Government Re-
5 form shall be considered as read and shall not be subject
6 to a point of order; and

7 (2) the previous question shall be considered as or-
8 dered on such resolution to adoption without intervening
9 motion or demand for division of the question except: (i)
10 50 minutes of debate equally divided and controlled by the
11 chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on
12 Oversight and Government Reform or their respective des-
13 ignees; (ii) after conclusion of debate one motion to refer
14 if offered by Representative Dingell of Michigan or his
15 designee which shall be separately debatable for 10 min-
16 utes equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
17 an opponent; and (iii) one motion to recommit with or
18 without instructions. The Chair may reduce the minimum
19 time for electronic voting on the question of adoption of
20 the motion to recommit as though pursuant to clause 9
21 of rule XX.

22 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
23 in order without intervention of any point of order to con-
24 sider in the House the resolution (H. Res. 706) author-
25 izing the Committee on Oversight and Government Re-

1 form to initiate or intervene in judicial proceedings to en-
2 force certain subpoenas. The resolution shall be considered
3 as read. The previous question shall be considered as or-
4 dered on the resolution to adoption without intervening
5 motion or demand for division of the question except: (1)
6 20 minutes of debate equally divided and controlled by the
7 Majority Leader and the Minority Leader or their respec-
8 tive designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.
