Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6156) to authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to products of the Russian Federation and Moldova and to require reports on the compliance of the Russian Federation with its obligations as a member of the World Trade Organization, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 6156) to authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory

1 treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to products  
2 of the Russian Federation and Moldova and to require re-  
3 ports on the compliance of the Russian Federation with  
4 its obligations as a member of the World Trade Organiza-  
5 tion, and for other purposes. All points of order against  
6 consideration of the bill are waived. An amendment in the  
7 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-  
8 mittee Print 112-33 shall be considered as adopted. The  
9 bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points  
10 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are  
11 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
12 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-  
13 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
14 except: (1) 90 minutes of debate, with 60 minutes equally  
15 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
16 member of the Committee on Ways and Means and 30  
17 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair and  
18 ranking minority member of the Committee on Foreign  
19 Affairs; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without  
20 instructions.

21       SEC. 2. On any legislative day during the period from  
22 November 19, 2012, through November 23, 2012—(a) the  
23 Journal of the proceedings of the previous day shall be  
24 considered as approved; (b) the Chair may at any time  
25 declare the House adjourned to meet at a date and time,

1 within the limits of clause 4, section 5, article I of the  
2 Constitution, to be announced by the Chair in declaring  
3 the adjournment; and (c) bills and resolutions introduced  
4 during the period addressed by this section shall be num-  
5 bered, listed in the Congressional Record, and when print-  
6 ed shall bear the date of introduction, but may be referred  
7 by the Speaker at a later time.

8       SEC. 3. The Speaker may appoint Members to per-  
9 form the duties of the Chair for the duration of the period  
10 addressed by section 2 of this resolution as though under  
11 clause 8(a) of rule I.
