## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6429) to amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to promote innovation, investment, and research in the United States, to eliminate the diversity immigrant program, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

- 1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 6429) to amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to

1 promote innovation, investment, and research in the  
2 United States, to eliminate the diversity immigrant pro-  
3 gram, and for other purposes. All points of order against  
4 consideration of the bill are waived. An amendment in the  
5 nature of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Com-  
6 mittee Print 112-34, modified by the amendment printed  
7 in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying  
8 this resolution, shall be considered as adopted. The bill,  
9 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of  
10 order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are  
11 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
12 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any amendment  
13 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except:  
14 (1) 90 minutes of debate equally divided and controlled  
15 by the chair and ranking minority member of the Com-  
16 mittee on the Judiciary; and (2) one motion to recommit  
17 with or without instructions.

18       SEC. 2. It shall be in order at any time on the legisla-  
19 tive day of December 6, 2012, for the Speaker to entertain  
20 motions that the House suspend the rules as though under  
21 clause 1 of rule XV.
