7 thereto, and to consider in the House, without intervention
8 of any point of order, a motion offered by the chair of
9 the Committee on the Judiciary or his designee that the
10 House concur in the Senate amendment. The Senate
11 amendment shall be considered as read. The motion shall
12 be debatable for one hour, with 40 minutes equally divided
13 and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member
14 of the Committee on the Judiciary and 20 minutes equally
15 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
16 member of the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
17 ligence. The previous question shall be considered as or-
18 dered on the motion to its adoption without intervening
19 motion.
