A BILL

To authorize the St. Croix River Crossing Project with appropriate mitigation measures to promote river values.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “St. Croix River Cross-
5 ing Project Authorization Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF PROJECT WITH MITIGATION**
2 **MEASURES.**

3 Notwithstanding section 7(a) of the Wild and Scenic
4 Rivers Act (16 U.S.C. 1278(a)), the head of any Federal
5 agency or department may authorize and assist in the con-
6 struction of a new extradosed bridge crossing the St. Croix
7 River approximately 6 miles north of the I-94 crossing
8 if the mitigation items described in paragraph 9 of the
9 2006 St. Croix River Crossing Project Memorandum of
10 Understanding for Implementation of Riverway Mitigation
11 Items, signed by the Federal Highway Administration on
12 March 28, 2006, and by the National Park Service on
13 March 27, 2006 (including any subsequent amendments
14 to the Memorandum of Understanding), are included as
15 enforceable conditions.

16 **SEC. 3. OFFSET.**

17 *To provide an offset for the funds made available to*
18 *carry out this Act, there is rescinded from the Department*
19 *of the Interior franchise fund authorized under section 113*
20 *of division A of title I of Public Law 104-208 (31 U.S.C.*
21 *501 note; 110 Stat. 3009-181) \$8,000,000.*

22 **SEC. 4. BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

23 *The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of*
24 *complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go-Act of 2010,*
25 *shall be determined by reference to the latest statement titled*
26 *“Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this Act,*

1 *submitted for printing in the Congressional Record by the*
2 *Chairman of the Senate Budget Committee, provided that*
3 *such statement has been submitted prior to the vote on pas-*
4 *sage.*
