## A BILL

To adjust the boundary of the Carson National Forest, New Mexico.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Carson National For-  
5       est Boundary Adjustment Act of 2011”.

6       **SEC. 2. CARSON NATIONAL FOREST BOUNDARY ADJUST-**  
7       **MENT.**

8       (a) IN GENERAL.—The boundary of the Carson Na-  
9       tional Forest in the State of New Mexico is adjusted to  
10      incorporate the approximately 4,990 acres of land gen-

1 erally depicted as “Miranda Canyon Boundary” on the  
2 map entitled “Carson National Forest Boundary Adjust-  
3 ment” and dated September 21, 2010.

4 (b) LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.—For  
5 purposes of section 7 of the Land and Water Conservation  
6 Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 4601–9), the boundaries  
7 of the Carson National Forest, as modified under sub-  
8 section (a), shall be considered to be the boundaries of  
9 the Carson National Forest as in existence on January  
10 1, 1965.
