A BILL

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project involving the American Falls Reservoir.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**
4 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT IN-**
5 **VOLVING AMERICAN FALLS RESERVOIR.**

6 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section
7 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would
8 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
9 mission project numbered 12423, the Federal Energy

1 Regulatory Commission shall, at the request of the li-
2 censee for the project, and after reasonable notice and in
3 accordance with the procedures of the Commission under
4 that section, reinstate the license and extend the time pe-
5 riod during which the licensee is required to commence
6 the construction of project works to September 25, 2013.
